CAPA

FCCC Development Officers and Manager meet with the Tusla Early Years Inspectorate team regularly. The purpose of these meetings is to share information and to look at common non-compliance that arise in the area during Inspections. We then work collectively to assist services in addressing issues that have been highlighted by the EYI's.

At our last meeting the issue of the accurate and timely completion of Inspection follow up documents was discussed.

As part of the follow up to your Inspection, you will be sent a Corrective Actions and Preventative Actions (CAPA) form. This is where Non Compliances have been documented in your Inspection Report. You are required to explain in the CAPA form how you intend to address each of the Non Compliances in order to meet regulatory requirements.

This form must be completed and returned via email to the Early Years Inspector within 10 working days of receiving your Inspection Report. It's vital that both the Corrective Actions and the Preventative Actions are both completed.

Access and Inclusion Model: Summary Report - Updated 12th January 2017

Early year's services within Fingal have made 99 applications to AIM, second highest in the country. Out of the 99 applications, 2 applications for Level 5, 11 Level 6 applications and 65 Level 7 applications have been approved. The remaining numbers may already have in place Level 6 assistance through the CHO (Community Healthcare Organization).

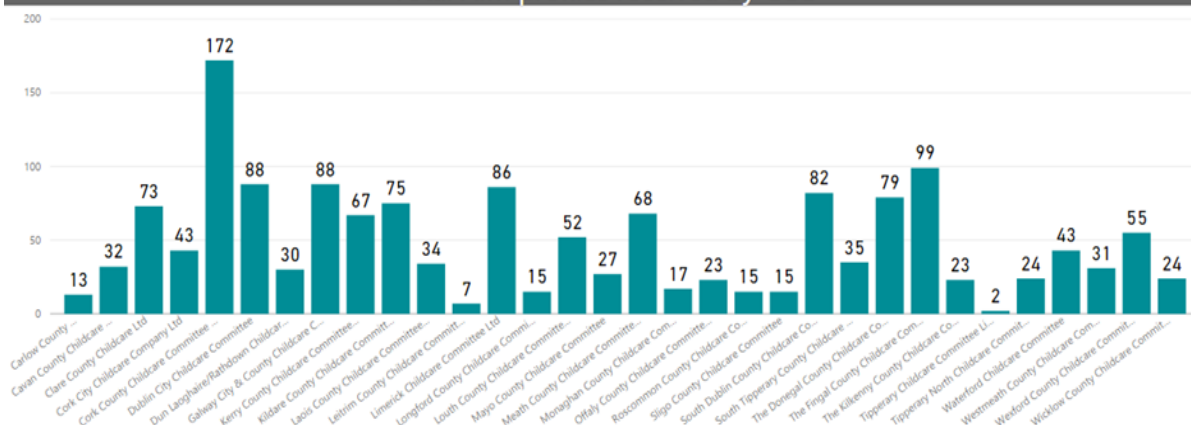
